£36 per month

Unlimited travel on all Thamesdown and Stagecoach buses within Swindon and to and from Wootton Bassett, Purton, Ashton Keynes, Cricklade, Highworth, South Marston, Bishopstone, Wanborough, Foxhill, Chiseldon and Draycot Foliat.

BOUNDARY POINTS: Wootton Bassett New Road; Ashton Keynes; Cricklade; Castle Eaton Red Lion; Haresfield Roundabout; South Marston Acorn Bridge; Bishopstone Pond; Foxhill Shepherd's Rest; Whitefields Hill; Draycot Foliat; Science Museum.

HOW DO I OBTAIN MY STUDENT TRAVELPASS?

- 1** Fill in an Application Form, available from Swindon College, New College or our Travel Shop in Fleming Way.
- 2** When completed bring it to the Travel Shop with a passport size photograph and photographic proof of age (eg CitizenCard).
- 3** If you are over 16 we also require proof of attendance at college or school (eg college identity card or letter from your school confirming you are in their 6th Form).
- 4** For first applications your Student TravelPass will be ready for collection from the Travel Shop within five working days from receipt of your application.



Student TravelPass and Student TravelPassPlus tickets will be issued on a smartcard.

These smartcards can be recharged, so you will not need a new one each time you renew your pass but a new Application Form will need to be completed at the start of each academic year.

You can renew your smartcard TravelPass at our Travel Shop in Fleming Way. And if your card is lost, stolen or damaged it can be 'hotlisted' to prevent it being used by anyone else and a replacement card issued (fee charged).

How to use a smartcard on a Thamesdown bus



Place the smartcard on the bullseye.

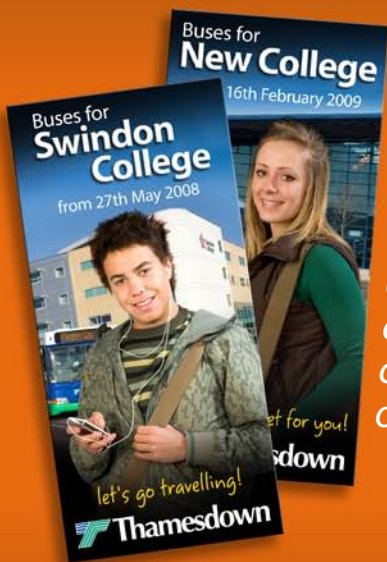


Take your ticket, which shows the expiry date of your pass. It confirms your entitlement to travel and should be retained for inspection.

PLEASE NOTE

To use a smartcard loaded with a TravelPass on a Stagecoach bus you will need to show your card AND a TravelPass ticket from a Thamesdown bus showing the card number and expiry date. If your first journey after buying or renewing your TravelPass is on a Stagecoach bus you will need to board a Thamesdown bus beforehand to obtain a ticket.
